The morning prayer

Enlighten our hearts that we may leave behind all works of darkness and live a new life as children of the light in complete devotion to You[23]. Bless us in proclaiming of Your Godly Word. Destroy the works of the devil. Strengthen every faithful servant of Your church and our authorities. Comfort every wounded and anxious heart. We pray this through Jesus Christ, Your beloved Son, who promised us that He will give us whatever we pray for in His Name and so commands us to pray:

Our Father who is in heaven,

hallowed be your name.

Your kingdom come.

Your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven.

Give us this day our daily bread,

and forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors.

And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil.

For yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory, forever.
